How and When to Register For Tot Soccer, First Touch, Mini Kickers and Recreational Soccer

Open Registration

*Recreational players only may register on line using a Visa, MasterCard or American Express (beginning November 15th) at www.bluesombrero.com/cobbfcc, in person (dates listed below) or through the mail. Paperwork must be postmarked by 1/21/2008 to be considered with regular registration.

- *If all teams are full players will be placed on a waiting list and placed on a team once an opening becomes available.
